## Did You Know? Library Resources

Each month we highlight a different library resource. This resource is either in print form, a service, or in an online format. This month is on **Wisconsin Digital Library**.



A state wide service started in 2001 that allows Wisconsin libraries to share ebooks, audiobooks, and streaming videos for free for all their library patron card holders.

As a library card holder, it's a great resource to have. Now patrons have access to so many more materials –all on their personal devices. Several of our staff members have been actively been using Libby (previously talked about in our February 2019 Newsletter). If you haven't tried Wisconsin Digital Library yet, stop in and meet one of our librarians (Braelyn, Cathy or Katie) who are familiar with this resource.

A couple great pros for this resource:

1. Items are automatically returned for you – so no late fees.
  2. You can choose your loan periods – 7 Days, 14 Days or 21 Days.
  3. Travelling? Why haul several suitcases or risk losing library books. You can check out up to 10 at a time on your phone, tablet or iPad.
  4. Overdrive / Libby are user friendly.

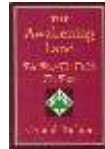


## Adult Book Clubs!
