Hotspots Now Available!

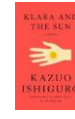
Internet slow at home? We've got a solution for you! We have 10! Yes, 10 hotspots that are available for checkout. To get one of these hotspots: you must be a current InfoSoup Library Card holder in good standing, be 18 years or older, and a permanent resident for 60 days (I.D. address must be current home address). Hotspots can be checked out for 7 days at a time (sorry only 1 per family/ household). These hotspots are only available at our location, meaning they are not sent to other libraries' patrons.
